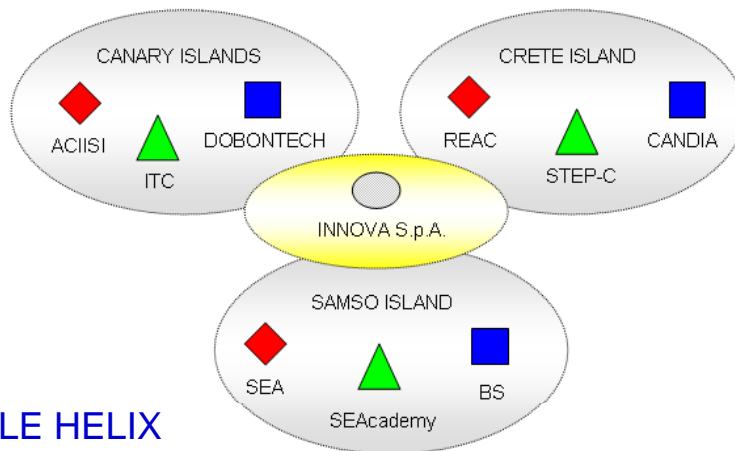

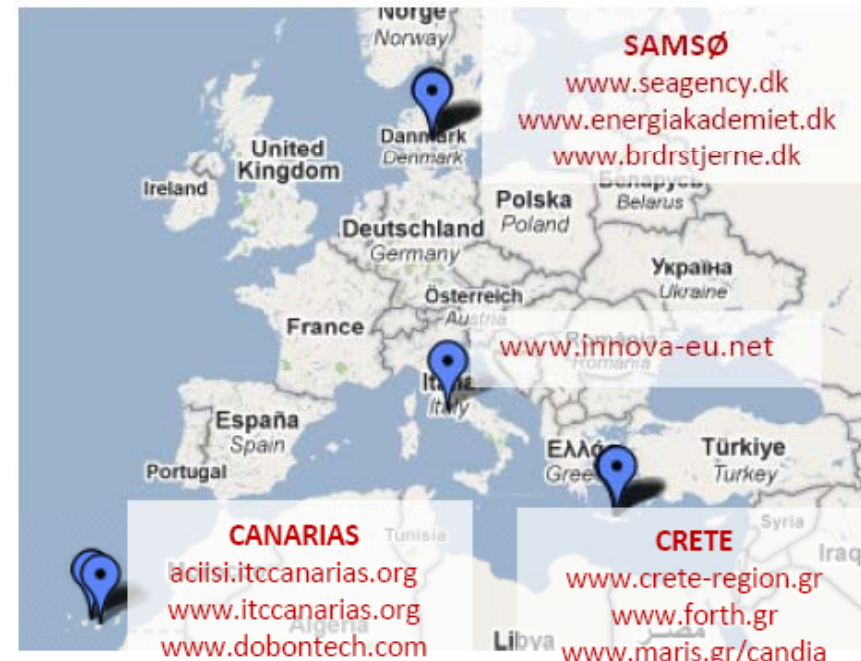
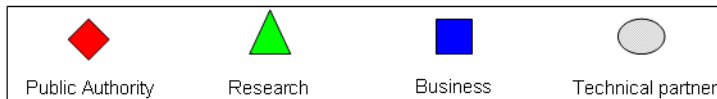
### 1 - Main objectives of the project:
